<b>Description</b> The church has a large attic space over top of the north-south and the east-west hallways at the west end of the building. We would like to make it more useable for storage by putting a floor in it. There is a medium sized access hole at one end which can be reached using the large step ladder. The project would involve screwing down 2'X8' sheets of OSB or Plywood (depending on price) to the rafters. The wood has to be cut to 2' in order to fit in the hole. It is a pretty straightforward job. There would be a small amount of custom cutting involved. The suggestion is to have the wood pre-cut (for free) at the hardware store when purchasing it. It would be good to use the opportunity to "rat-proof", the area by filling all access points with "Great Stuff."
